



PLEASE NOTE: The Boston University (BU) Fitness and Recreation Center will be open for regular business throughout the duration of the Massachusetts Dance Festival (MDF). Please adhere to the following facility guidelines and be considerate of BU members, classes, and other regular activities.

1. Pre-registration to MDF is important: Any guests who cannot swipe into the facility using a Terrier ID card must be on a guest list submitted to the manager in advance. It is the responsibility of MDF to ensure that the guest list is accurate. Those individuals who cannot swipe, and are not on the guest list, will not be permitted to enter the facility. Guest who are not pre-registered may do so on the day of the event at the Buick Street Entrance with MDF staff.
2. All MDF participants must sign an informed consent and waiver of liability before entering the Boston University facility. It is downloadable from the MDF site or at the door on the day of the event. For BU students and FitRec members, this form is signed online – your Terrier Card will not swipe you into the facility if this form hasn't been signed. All MDF participants will have to sign a paper waiver form before entering. For any participants under the age of 18, this form must be signed by a parent or legal guardian.
3. Cell Phones: The use of cell phones is prohibited throughout the facility.
4. Food, Chewing Gum and Drinks: Food, chewing gum and drinks are permitted in the Healthy Blends café area only unless prior arrangements are made and approved by the management. Glass containers are prohibited at all times. Water is allowed in activity areas only if it is in an enclosed, unbreakable container.
5. Smoking: Smoking and tobacco products are prohibited in the facility and at active entrances.
6. Alcohol and Drugs: Alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs may not be consumed prior to or while using the facility. Individuals may not use the facility while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
7. Bicycles, etc.: Bicycles, roller skates, rollerblades, scooters, and skateboards are prohibited inside the facility at all times. Exceptions for sports such as inline hockey will be made in designated areas only.

8. Pets: Except for guide animals, pets are prohibited in all facilities.
9. Moving Equipment: Only Fitness and Recreation Center staff may move equipment or walls in the facility.
10. Spitting: Spitting is prohibited in the Fitness and Recreation Center.
11. Posted Rules: Specific policies and room regulations are posted on site and must be observed. Verbal instructions issues by all staff should be strictly followed.
12. Personal Belongings: The Fitness and Recreation Center is not responsible for, stolen or damaged personal property. Day lockers area available for use throughout the facility. We recommend locking valuables and personal belongings in a day locker. Unsecured belongings will be considered abandoned property and turned in to the lost and found located at the ProShop.
